Nan Loveland welcomed members, then introduced OFDNA board members and guests. After thanking Pat Moran for serving on the board, Nan requested those who are interested to please sign up. Nan requested members to e-mail the survey answers, if possible otherwise, mail them to the address provided.

Mat Clifford reported on the Reed Market Corridor Study by the City. OTAC & Perimetrics contracted by City. The OFDNA study will be presented to the City before the public meeting. Matt requested that members help us spread the word and encourage other members to respond to be a voice of the association.

Nan introduced Diane Ross and she identified that we are still waiting for the city on a Budget.

Cindy Kettering, Bend Fire Dept. Inspector, explained Fire Free Program which is creating a defensible space around your home by breaking the "ladder" where fire can climb from shrubs and trees to your house. Cindy also explain how address markers to identify house can be helpful. During the forest fire season, be aware of current fires by watching TV and by being prepared and having a plan to contact family members, pack the car and evacuate early. Cindy also explained that any neighbor who is concerned about neighbors' weeds/grass should call Fire Dept.

Steve Esselstyn, Bend Police Dept. spoke about identity theft and drug houses. He explained the correlation and the need to help them identify drug houses and how to protect yourself against identify theft.

After thanking Cindy and Steve for their time, Nan asked member to check in with John and to sign up if they are interested in a board position.
