Reports

- 1) Reed Market Road meeting/workshop October 6th. Ann Sylvester, of Parametrics, talked about roundabout statistics. The workshop was broken into three parts: west, middle and east sections.
WEST Talk was of a roundabout at Reed and Division, 5 lanes for Reed near third and four lanes otherwise.
MIDDLE Brosterhous should go through to Reed Market. The majority wanted roundabouts.
EAST 15th Street to 27th Street. The Tanglewood residents were very verbal. They would like a sound wall. Roundabouts won out over signals.
- 2) Nan relayed information from Mat. He reported that at the Bend Chamber meeting, they decided that the entrance to Juniper Ridge should go further to the north than Cooley Road.

Old Business

- 1) The board voted unanimously to join the Chamber of Commerce.
- 2) Concerning the Good Samaritan project, Leslie will email our membership with the information and it will go on the website.
- 3) During Fall Festival, Laura collected samples of other neighborhood association's brochures. Laura and Kathy will work on a brochure for OFDNA in time for the winter Festival in February.

- 1) There was a discussion on if we should weigh in on the new development code for Bend. We didn't feel the need to do this as a group.
- 2) Daryl brought up a concern about the towers on Aubrey Butte: When the towers become obsolete, the people responsible for them should take them down.
- 3) We had a short discussion about moving the meeting back to the third Thursday. Will carry over to the next meeting on November 10th.
