

OFDNA Board Minutes  
May 18, 2006

OFDNA board members present: Nan Loveland, Kathy Henderson, Mat Clifford, Leslie Perry, Lewis Hollander and Shirley Walkey. Also present Land-use Chair Daryl Loveland.

April minutes were approved with one change.

## Reports

- 1) Kathy – There wasn't a good turnout for the community cleanup. No one actually came to it but some individuals at the school for a game helped to clean up the school area.

The next meeting for the Larkspur Park/Senior Center benefit is on the 26<sup>th</sup>. They still need vendors, more volunteers and another child's booth.

- 2) Information from our general meeting. Three people in our NA were interested in Neighborhood Watch, two people for the weed pull, two for Good Samaritan and one for transportation. We had 30 people at the general meeting, seven of which were new sign-ups.
- 3) Lewis inquired about City putting up our OFDNA signs. He hadn't heard back from Andrea but Nan did. The signs will be \$195.00 each and Andrea has the money for installation.
- 4) Nan – Officers and Chairs meeting and the NART (Neighborhood Assn. Round table) meetings:

Dealin' Signs makes yard signs for advertising events, similar to the ones realtors use. The cost is \$300.00 for 18 signs. We could buy the basic signs with our association information and change the dates and other information as needed.

Dianne Ross talked about Blakely Park – supposedly a neighborhood park but the traffic is so dangerous that people can't walk there and there's no parking.

The City Council voted at last night's meeting to keep City Hall where it is.

Mel Oberst said the city planners will be revising procedures with development applications. The problem is that the information gathered at the pre-application meetings with the neighbors is not making it to the City. Mel is open to suggestions and making changes to tighten up the procedures. Nan will send out a draft form for us to look at that will then be sent to Mel for possible inclusion in the tentative plan application process. Mat suggested that we could schedule a meeting with some of

the COBA members to discuss the situation and try to come up with a solution.

- 5) Our City Council presentation is on June 7<sup>th</sup>. Those of us who can, should go.
- 6) The weed pull is June 10<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 until noon. There is a barbecue in Drake Park afterwards. We have posters to put up if we have a place to put them. Leslie will put the information on our web site.
- 7) Budget:
