**Board Meeting – May 31, 2005
6:30 pm – Newton residence**

Attendees: Jeanne Newton, Jim Mazziotti and Lynn Russell.

I. Open House

- The Board discussed plans for the General Membership Open House to be held June 6 at 7 pm @ Real Life Christian Church.
- Jeanne visited the Church and viewed the meeting room; she recommended using a table in the foyer to greet members with a sign up sheet and name tags.
- Jeanne will bring the MVNA flip chart stand and territory poster with post-it flags for people to identify where they live on the poster
- Jeanne will welcome attendees and review the purpose of the meeting is to select committees; there will be a table or grouping for each committee; she will announce that each Board member will act as liaison to a committee(s). The Board agreed to the assignments as follows:
 - Traffic/Safety – Jeanne
 - Land Use – Jim
 - Membership & Communications – Lynn
- The Committees will meet in discussion group to identify issues/procedures; identify a Committee Chair, establish date for each Committee to meet
- Jeanne will ask members if they think we need to conduct a Neighborhood survey
- She will recruit helpers for Weed Pull and may have to send out reminder emails/postcards

2. Weed Pull

- Jeanne advised that The Let's Pull Together Neighborhood weed pull is scheduled for June 18, 9-12; the MVNA site is the lot at the NE corner of Connors & 27th. It is a site owned by group of MDs from the Center; Jeanne spoke with Patricia Heatherman, agent for the Corporation to obtain verbal approval from the owners to go on the property; until we receive it we can do the Right of Way; 10 feet in from sidewalk on Connors; 15 feet in from 27th; rest of site if no objection from the owners
- Jim to contact Whispering Winds Assisted Living behind property to see if volunteers can use their bathrooms

3. Other Business

- Jeanne advised that the Bite of Bend is also June 18 from 9:45 am to 10 pm; Diane Ross has been asking for volunteers for 2 hour shifts to sign people up for Neighborhood Associations; Lynn to ask Membership Committee members if they can attend
- Jeanne is trying to find a current Homeowners Association Listing in order to build membership; Jim to request one from a title company he works with
- Jeanne advised the Board of quotes from Carlson Sign for a banner: 3 ft. by 8 ft. - \$154; smaller size – 22 inches by 50 inches - \$111. She also requested a price for an A-frame/sandwich board - \$297. The Board agreed that the smaller banner size is approved. Jim will contact a vendor about a quote for a sandwich board.
- Jeanne reported that the MVNA Website is updated with minutes and Lets Pull Together event
- Jeanne advised that the City is seeking Applicants for Bend's Traffic Safety Committee; participation on this committee might be valuable for MVNA
