

Southeast Bend Neighborhood Association
Minutes
1-16-08

The meeting was called to order at 7:10. Board members who were present were Ron Garland, Richard Selby, John Snippen, Ellen Glasgow, John Alkire, Harold Anderson and Kristi Erickson. All in attendance approved the minutes.

Financial Report

Ellen reported that we have \$2264.87 left in our budget.

Land Use Report

Ron reported that the Deer Ridge subdivision has been approved. He went to hearings and went over a variety of sewer options they are looking at.

Building has slowed down considerably. Nothing else has been approved recently.

General Information

Harold suggested that we use the extra mailers we have to send out brochures with an insert asking questions

We discussed further the sewer and septic situation in Bend. Harold went through a handout displaying maps showing the city's current sewers and septic systems.

Murphy road had six options. After our presentation to Nick Arnis, some headway was made. Harold read the minutes from the presentation to the council. The details of that presentation were discussed and the Murphy project has been moved to design.

Ellen attended the Bend Metro Park and Recreation District meeting. She reported that the city wants to connect as many of the city trails as possible, including the river access. They are also looking for a representative from each neighborhood association to serve on a committee. The Parks and Recreation department would like input from the neighborhood associations with any positive or negative feedback. Ellen proposed that we consider the adopt a park or trail for our association. It is for six months at a time. We will think about it for a later date.

Harold touched on the state of the Urban Growth Boundary.

We have decided not to have a booth at the Bend Winterfest this year.

We are going to draft a letter to Burlington Railroad concerning the noise at the crossings in the neighborhoods.

Sharon Leighty has submitted her resignation but has offered to stay involved as a consultant or will work on special projects. The board moved to regretfully accept it, all were in favor.

Richard volunteered for and has been accepted to the Transit Committee.
