

**Southeast Bend Neighborhood Association**  
**Minutes**  
**4-16-08**

The meeting was called to order at 7:10. Board members who were present were Ron Garland, Richard Selby, Maureen Schlerf, Harold Anderson, John Alkire, Ellen Glasgow and Kristi Erickson. All in attendance approved the March minutes.

**Financial Report**

Ellen reported we have \$ 2,229.87 in our account at this time, which should be around \$300 less next time due to our upcoming mailing.

**Land Use Report**

Ron reported that Wood hill is asking for eleven additional lots. They are proposing to make some lots smaller and put duplexes or townhouses on them, which are still categorized as single-family dwellings. This is a way to get around the sewer situation and get more families on the property. They did get rid of the narrow intersections, which are hard for fire trucks to negotiate.

**General Information**

Ron reported on the Fire Free Wildfire Defense day, which will be held in the Mountain Pines subdivision. There will be trailers available for people to put yard debris in. Trailers will be parked at these locations Saturday, April 19<sup>th</sup> from 9:00a.m. – 4:00p.m. Harold will check the trailers often and take them to the landfill to unload them. The Knott landfill will have free yard debris drop off April 19-27. We need to get the word out so that we utilize this great offer from Service Master.

Dick reported that the transit committee is proposing a transportation district. The cost would be close to .39 per \$1000. It will be on the ballot in November. The public transit is in financial trouble, and they are cutting their service. The bus drivers are threatening to go out. Oran Teater is going to be in charge of the financial end of trying to get this levy passed.

Dick is adding new information to the website as he receives it. Ellen suggested that we put information about the Let's Pull Together and a show on OPB addressing the issue that is coming up.

We discussed when to send the brochures out to maximize attendance at our general meeting. One suggestion was one week before the meeting. We decided to give it a little more time in case of any trouble with the mail.

Becky McDonald from 911 will be attending our meeting. We will have our website on a presenter to show people how to negotiate through it. Dick will do that. John Snippen will put together the agenda, and introduce the guests as well as the board members. Board members will take certain topics and present them. It was suggested to touch on the homeless camp issue and that it is being resolved in this area. Dick will add the homeless camp issue to the broadcast he will be putting out before the general meeting.

Ellen will be getting cookies for the general meeting and Maureen will get the coffee. Kristi will bring the banners and help setup the media center at the school.
