Minutes for  
General meeting  
October 17, 2007

### **Call to Order**

President Harold Anderson called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m. The meeting was held at the R.E. Jewell Elementary School on Murphy Rd.

Board members present were: Ellen Glasgow, John Snippen, Harold Anderson, Sharon Leighty, Richard Selby and Kristi Erickson. There were 47 people in attendance.

Harold gave a brief introduction. He highlighted the board member's jobs and gave an overview of his position. The board members introduced themselves.

### **Financial Report**

Ellen reported that we have \$2584.51 in our budget.

### **Introduction of Guest Speakers**

John Snippen introduced our guest speakers Captain Mark Mills and Sergeant Scott Shelton from the Deschutes County Sheriff's office. Scott filled in for Sergeant Mike Espinosa who was originally scheduled to speak but was unable to attend.

Captain Mills and Sergeant Shelton gave a comprehensive presentation detailing the variety of jobs carried out by the Sheriff's department. They discussed a variety of topics including the county jail being over capacity, serving civil summons, transportation to and from court, search and rescue and emergency management.

The bulk of their presentation was about street crimes, which directly affect the quality of life in our neighborhoods. Some of the crimes affecting our area are mailbox and identity theft, drug houses and methamphetamine labs as well as a large group of homeless people living on China Hat road.

They answered several questions and made themselves available after the meeting for more in depth conversations.

### **Meeting Adjourned**

Board president Harold Anderson gave some closing remarks. He spoke about our neighborhood associations, the state of Juniper Ridge, and the Murphy Road expansion project. He informed the meeting attendees about the way projects like Murphy Road are prioritized. Harold closed the meeting around 9:00 p.m. He informed the members that the next general meeting would be held in April.
